

5 STEPS TO CONDUCT JSA

- Determine Job Tasks: Select individual tasks to be analyzed prior to beginning the JSA.
- 2 Identify Hazards: Consider hazards produced by the environment and conditions connected to the task deemed problematic.
- Assess Risks:
 Determine risks by comparing frequency and probability of potential hazards.
- Control Measures:
 Decide what actions are necessary to minimize the identified hazards.
- 5 Communicate with the team: Involve employees affected by potential changes and continue to search for feedback.
